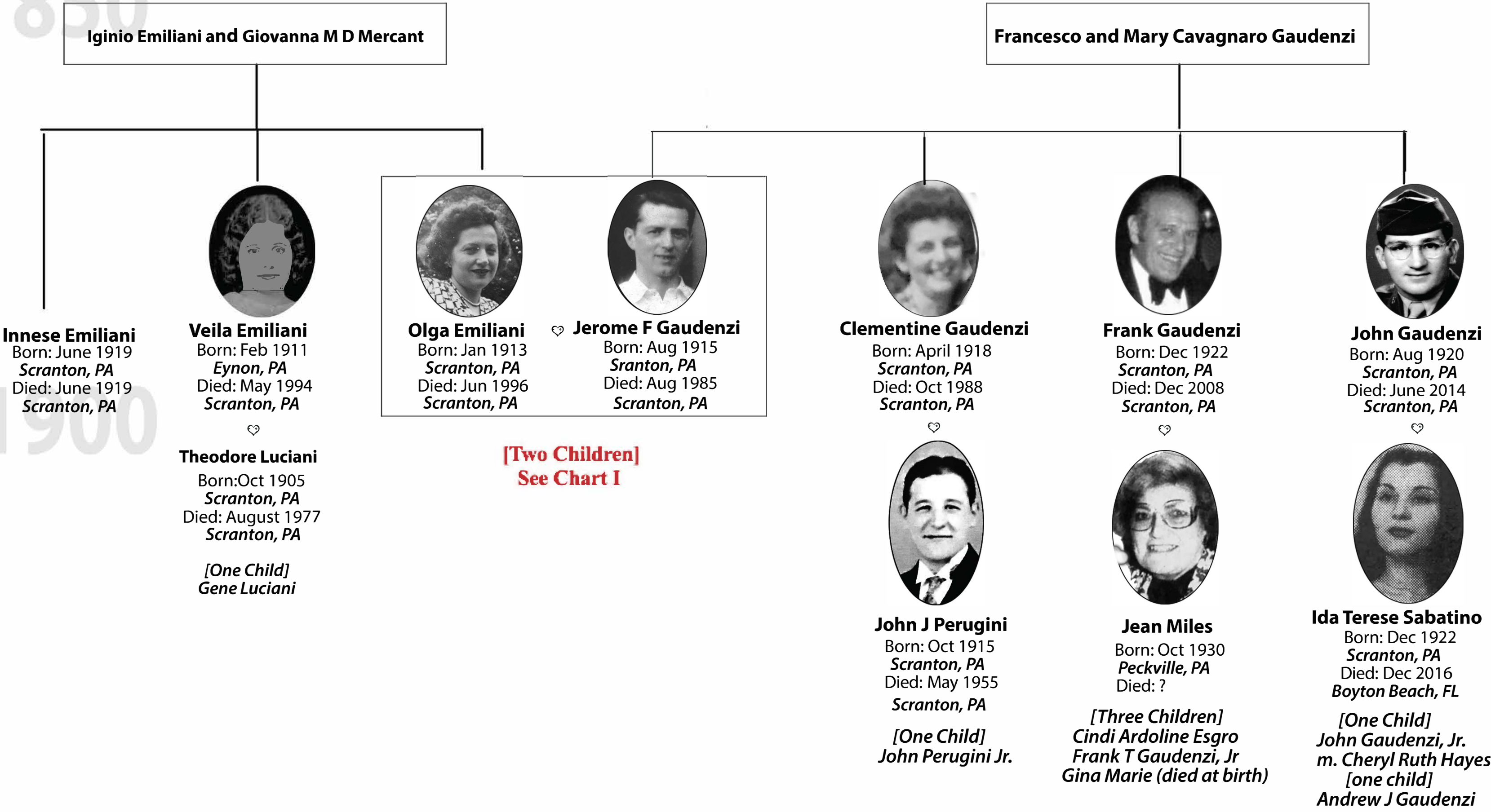

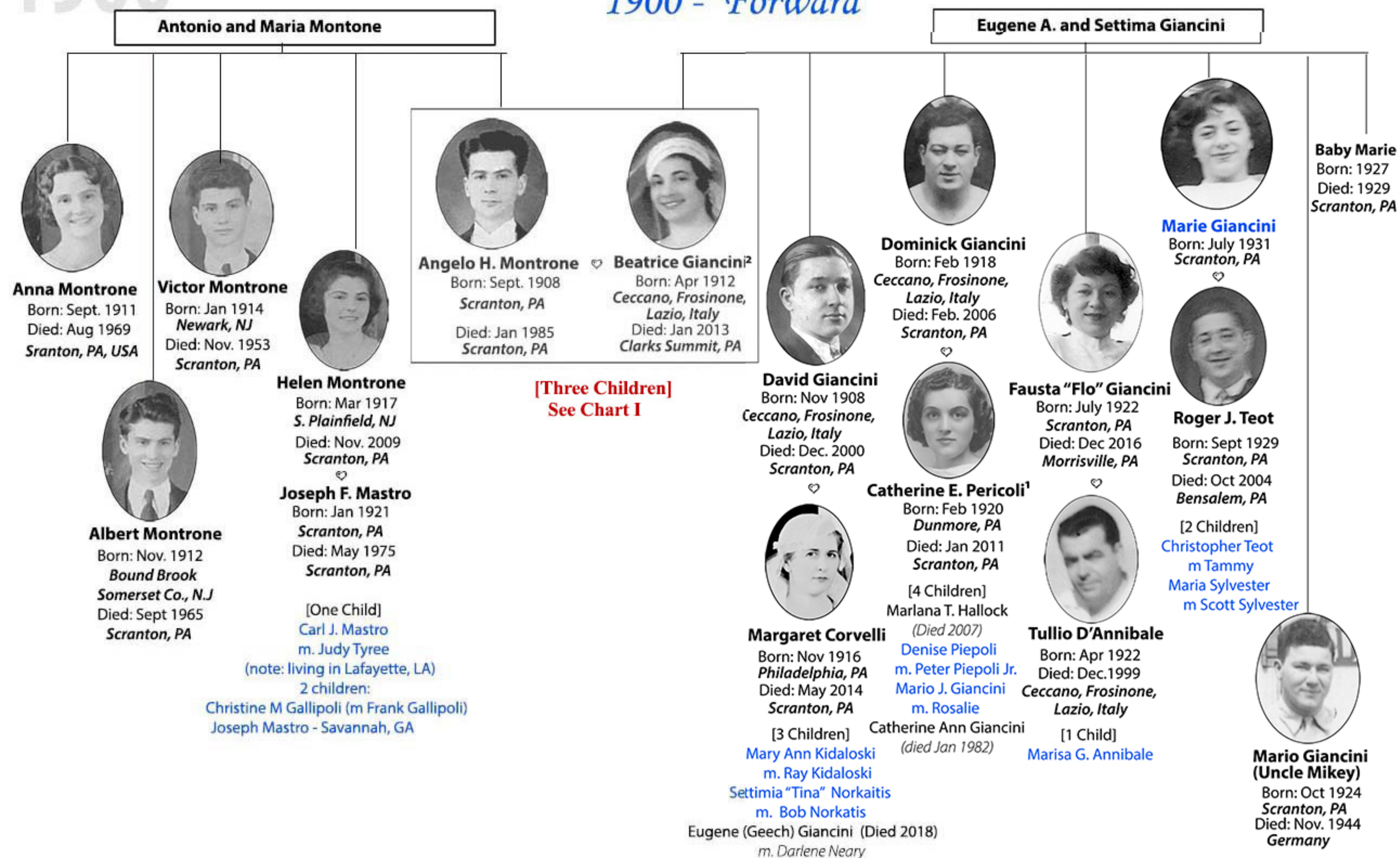
V. The Gaudenzi, Cavagnaro and Bava Families 1700 - 1850s

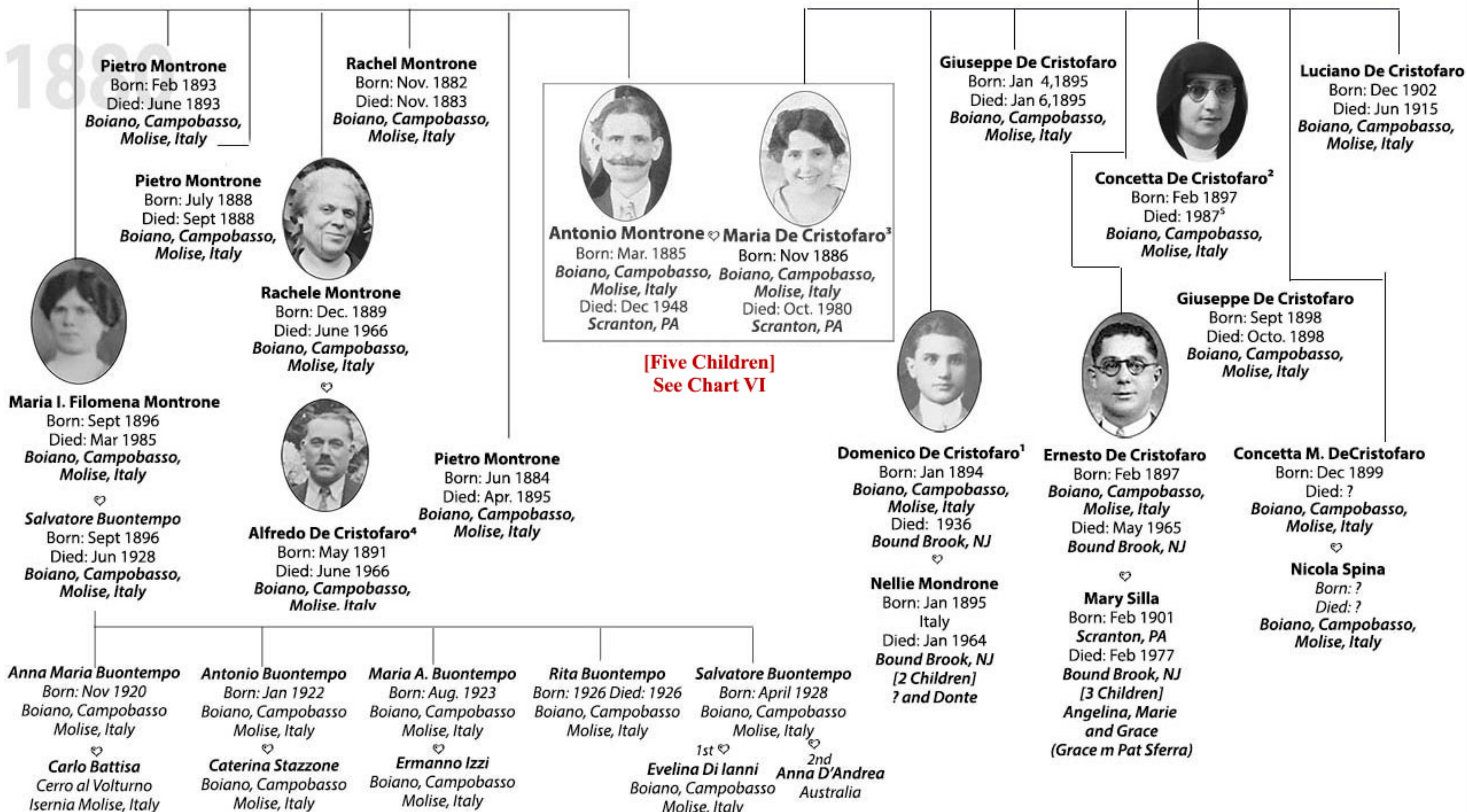

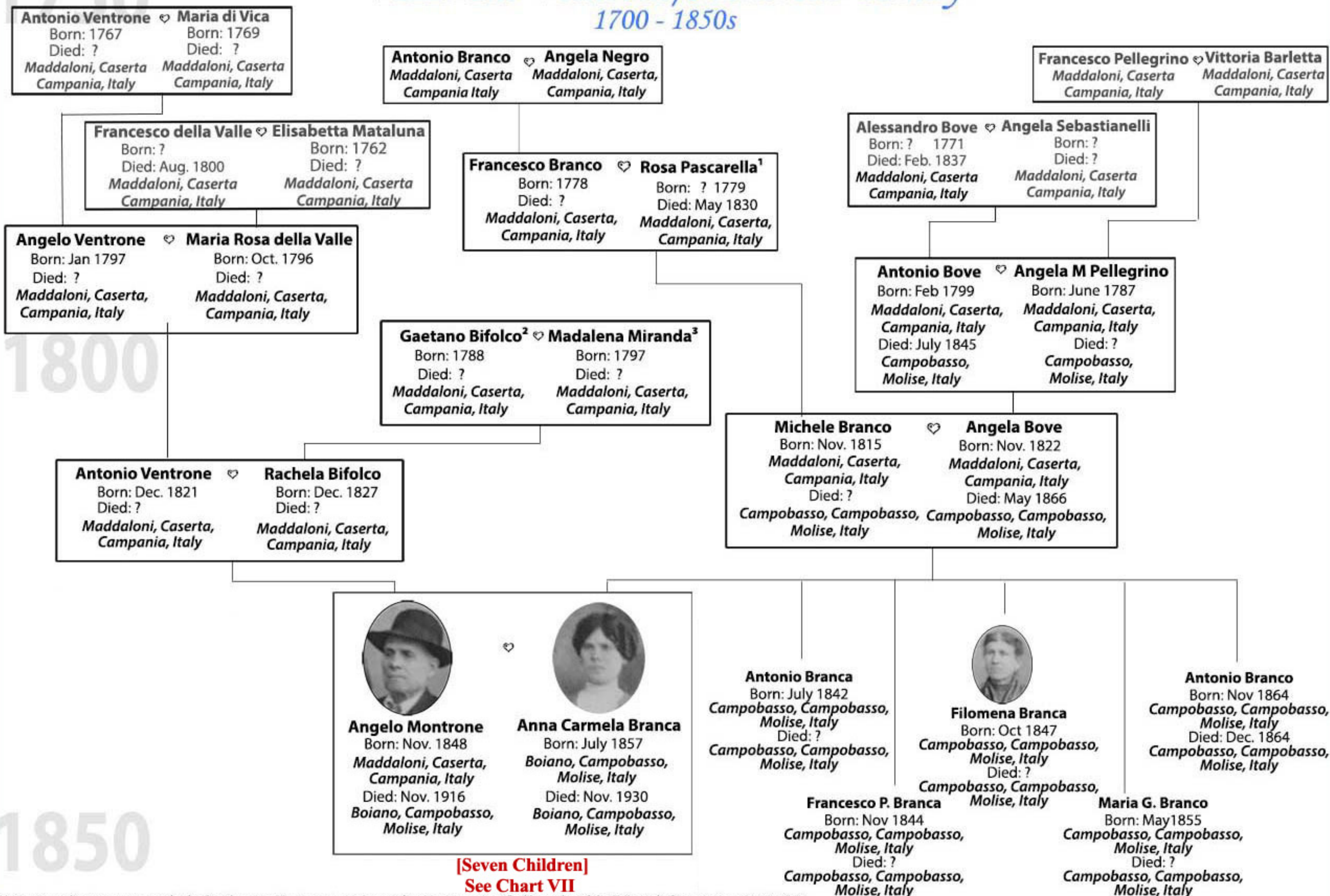

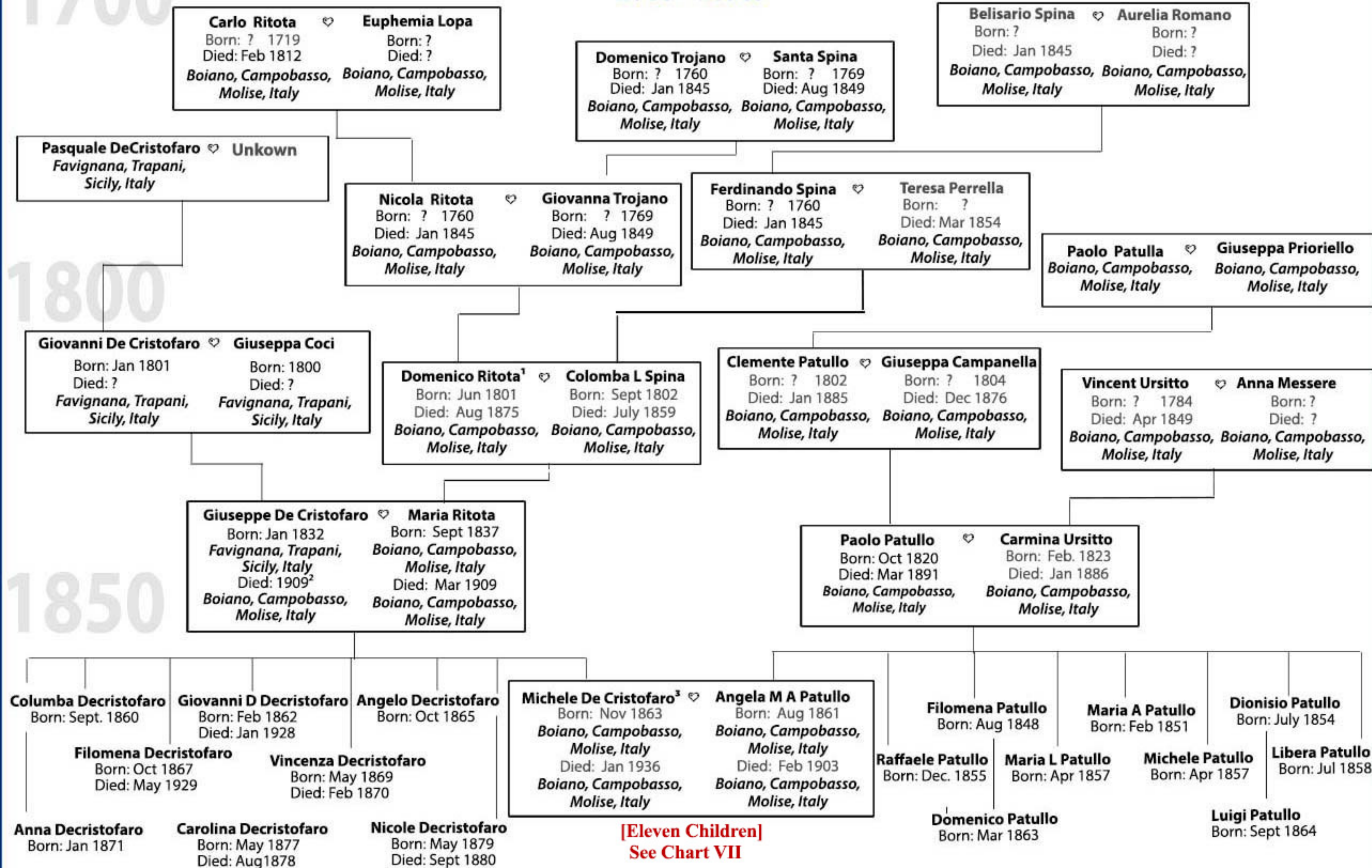
IX. The DeCristofaro Family

1. Different sources spell the surname Ritota differently. It has been spelled Rutola or Rotula. 2. Giuseppe De Cristofaro's exact date of his death is unknown but believed to be in or about 1909. 3. Michele de Cristoforo lost his first wife, Angela, in 1903. Still a young man, Michele married a second time - his second wife was Maria Vittoria Milano. They had 3 children, but only one lived past the age of five.
